Last year was our 175th anniversary and the challenge was to give \$175 million dollars to win the world to Christ. A full 100% of that money goes directly to the missionaries on the field. The goal was to give \$175 million but when the receipts came in we exceeded that amount and gave \$177.6 million! The single largest annual giving to International Missions around the world in our 176 Years of existence! Our church gave \$23,930.02 which was itself over \$3,000 more than our goal. Well done church, well done!
